## The Friends of the Library

The Graham Library is heavily supported by The Friends of the Library, both as individual benefactors and by the corporate revenue from more than three decades of annual Friends' Book Sales. In addition to this material support, the energetic cordence of the Friends has long sustained the hope and vision that is embodied in Trinity's new library.

Founded in November , the Friends' objectives are several: to promote the welfare of the library; to provide funds for acquisitions and special projects; to encourage gifts and bequests of books and manuscripts to the Library and Archives; and to promote awareness of the Library's resources by organizing exhibitions and programmes of literary and historical interest.

The Book Sale, an event which involves over 200volunteers—many working year round to sort, price and display more than volumes—annually attracts over readers, collectors and bibliophiles to the College during ve days in October. Over the years revenue from the Sale has funded book and equipment acquisitions and the cataloguing and restoration of the Rare Books Collection. Accumulated earnings from the Sale enabled the Friends to give , to help build the Graham Library and 1,000,00 to endow book acquisitions, and to pled 1,000,00 to wards the endowment of the Nicholls librarianship.

The Friends also produce and sell book bags and a series of greeting cards using images from illustrated works in the library collections.
